



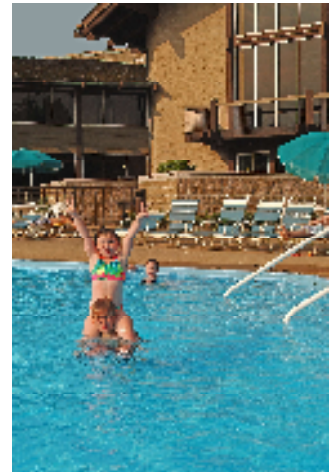

Guernsey County offers fall weekend getaway events
