For the fifth year, the VCB will offer the Grant Assistance Program (GAP) funds to assist qualified non-profit organizations with the advertising and promotion of activities which directly increase lodging occupancy in designated periods throughout the year, create positive image building publicity for the Cambridge/Guernsey County area, and enhance the tourism environment of our area.

Grants are available from a minimum of \$500 to \$5,000 and will be contingent upon the amount of overnight stays the event, project, or program generates.
