

Edible Adventures in Southeast Ohio

CAMBRIDGE, OHIO (July 12, 2016) – Southeast Ohio offers a unique blend of edible adventures, ranging from farmers markets, to eclectic restaurants, and local wineries. Check-out these summer road trip wonders.

Inspired by the eclectic energy of downtown Cambridge, Ohio, **Guernsey Kitchen** offers a fresh, locally produced menu with healthy, delicious food in an urban setting. The restaurant is located within a restored 19th-century building with original tin ceilings and hard wood floors. It offers patrons a unique dining experience from the ambient decor to inviting staff to the way it sources its food. The restaurant's fresh, scratch-made, locally sourced foods, including burgers and hand cut fries along with a variety of specialty sandwiches, pastas, salads, appetizers, and deserts are



sumptuous. Guernsey Kitchen is open Monday through Saturday from 11am-2:30pm Sunday – Tuesday and 11am-8pm Wednesday – Saturday. Before or after your meal, stop by McKenna's Market right next door and pick up a few gourmet goodies to take home. <http://guernseykitchen.com>

Georgetown Vineyards sits high atop a scenic ridge overlooking the city of Cambridge, Ohio. The winery is surrounded by five acres of vineyards. Family owned and operated, the winery specializes in a varied selection of award-winning wines, from dry California styles to sweet Ohio varietals. Wine tastings are offered during normal business hours in the retail shop (Monday through Thursday, 11am-5pm & Friday and Saturday 11am-8pm). There is a nominal charge (25 cents) for a tasting. Organized tours are not offered, however, guests are welcome to explore the grounds and enjoy the view of Cambridge. Located a few miles out of town, **Terra Cotta Vineyards** offers gorgeous views and picture-perfect sunsets. Guests may sample their favorite wines by relaxing with a glass on the back porch or inside tasting room. Cheese and crackers and nosh plates are available to enjoy with the wines.

Terra Cotta offers numerous unique food and wine events to enjoy. One of the most popular events is the monthly Chef in the Vineyard Dinners. Each dinner features a two entrée multicourse dinner with a flaming dessert presentation at the end. Reservations are required. <http://www.terracottavineyards.com>

Finally, stop by two local farmer's markets, the **Cambridge Main Street** and **Guernsey County Farmers Markets** and pick from homegrown fresh fruits, vegetables, flowers and homemade goods. The Guernsey County Farmers Market takes place on Thursdays from 8am-noon at the Guernsey County Fairgrounds. The Cambridge Main Street Farmers Market opens every Friday from 9am-1pm in Historic Downtown Cambridge.
