



## the Wilds Ride

## From Cambridge

■ Take Rt. 40, the Old National Road (Wheeling Ave, goes through <u>Historic Down-town Cambridge</u>) West out of Cambridge approx. 8 miles to New Concord. (Visit the <u>John & Annie Glenn Historic Site</u> on Main St. in New Concord for a unique walk through history!).

At the stoplight of Main St. and Highway 83, turn left (South). Be prepared for a wonderful ride with great scenery, and if you need a quick lunch or ice cream, visit The Banana Peel, just past I-70.

■ Stay on 83 to Cumberland, turn West (right) on 340, also follow signs to <u>the Wilds</u>. It is well marked.

Enjoy a wonderful day at the Wilds, one of the largest and most innovative wildlife conservation centers in the world.

To enjoy a more scenic return ride, leave the Wilds North on 284, head East on 313, cross under I-77.



Head North on 285 which brings you back up to either I-70 or Rt. 40, and head West back into Cambridge. (This makes a nice, round-about ride for about a 1-hour return trip.)
