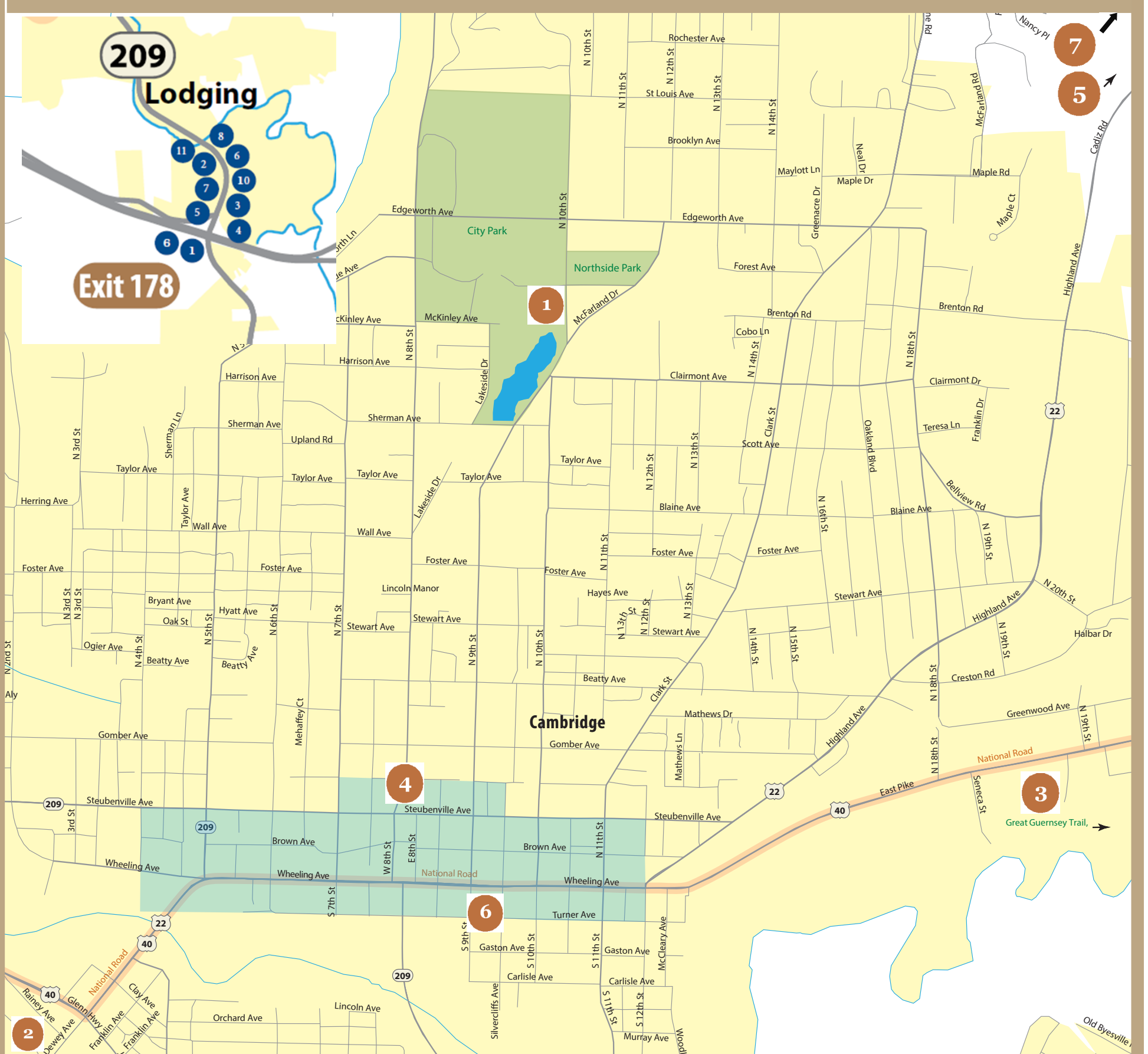

- *Early travelers reached the area by traveling along Zane's trace, a trail cleared out of the wilderness in 1796 that linked Kentucky to Ohio and points west. The National Road (U.S. Route 40) was built through Guernsey County in 1827 to replace this trail.*
- *Morgan's Raid, an incursion by Confederate cavalry into Indiana and Ohio during the Civil War, took place from June 11-July 26, 1863 and passed through Old Washington, a pike town along the National Road in Guernsey County.*
- *John Glenn, U.S. Senator and Astronaut, was the first American to orbit the Earth. Glenn's boyhood home stands in New Concord.*
- *The Guernsey County Courthouse was built in 1881.*
