Join us for the 15th season of the Dickens Victorian Village at Cambridge, Ohio. From November to the first of January, visitors can experience a touch of old world England through 96 classic Victorian scenes. Approximately 180 lifelike figures are stationed along Wheeling Avenue at lamp posts, benches, and in store windows depicting society of that time. Each life sized mannequin is hand crafted, painted and dressed in period clothing to provide an authentic Victorian look.

This highly successful project was the brainchild of local businessman and artist Bob Ley, who envisioned the concept, created sketches of each scene and organized the beginning of the Dickson Victorian Village committee. In 2006, the project began with a \$2000 grant from the city of Cambridge. Over the years the project has grown with the addition of many new scenes. Hundreds of local volunteers have embraced this project to insure its continuance so future generations can get a glimpse of the past by visiting the Dickens Victorian Village.
