The guide will be distributed to groups, area businesses, events, attractions, lodging properties, state travel centers and individuals in the coming year.

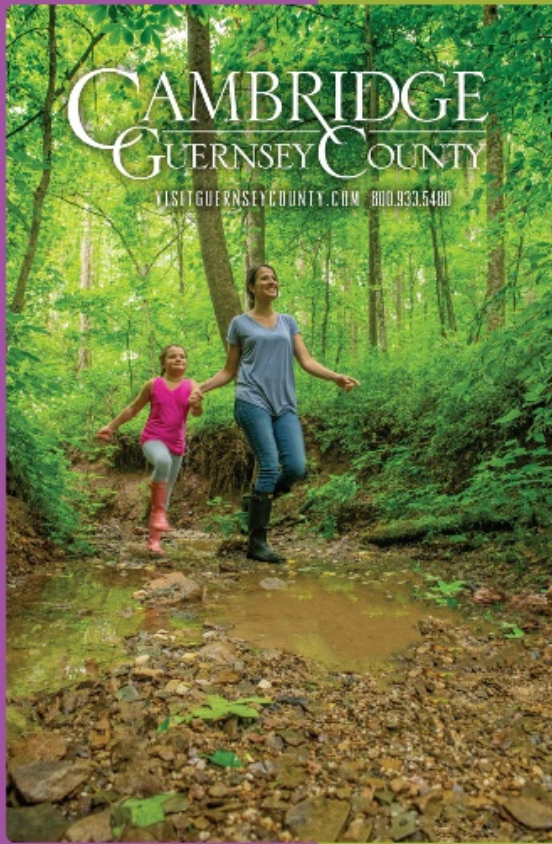
Residents are encouraged to stop by the Tourist Information Center in downtown Cambridge to pick up copies for family reunions, weddings, or for visiting friends and relatives.
