It's hard to believe we're wrapping up the year. As the Cambridge/Guernsey County Visitors & Convention Bureau Board of Directors and staff look back on 2016 we're very pleased and impressed with the results.

### We're pleased because ...

During the past year, we expanded our marketing campaign and extended our audience reach to include several new online services, such as Trip Advisor, and a new national publication, Food Traveler. The increased exposure helped to drive more requests for information about the Cambridge/Guernsey County area.

The bureau continued its outdoor board campaign for a second year in the Zanesville market featuring events by our tourism partners April through November. And, for a third year, we renewed our cable television campaign in Columbus, Akron/Canton and Cleveland - featuring five seasonal commercials May through November.

We pursued new initiatives in 2016 including a "Made in Cambridge" web video that will be promoted through our social media channels soon. We also completed a comprehensive visitor study with our hotel partners.

To cap off the year, the bureau was once again recognized for its outstanding marketing efforts by the Ohio Travel Association. The VCB was recognized with two Ruby Awards within its budget division during the Ohio Conference on Travel Oct. 27 in Columbus, Ohio. The bureau received first place honors for its print advertising campaign and a Citation of Excellence award for its fall television commercial.
