## **Forgotten Places & Spaces**

If you've ever been curious about some of the historic buildings in downtown Cambridge, the Forgotten Places & Spaces Walking Tour is an event you must put on your to-do list. Held monthly on the last Saturday (except Nov. & Dec.) from 3-4:30 p.m., each quarter of the year will feature a different theme.

Tours depart from the monument on the Courthouse lawn and are guided by a costumed interpreter who leads the group from building to building. Tickets are \$20 per person with proceeds to benefit historic preservation efforts in downtown Cambridge. (The first project for 2016 is the replacement of the historical plaques which adorn the 33 buildings in the historic district that are included in a self-guided walking tour brochure.) In June, July and August, Rock the Block: Rhythm & Art Walk will be held in conjunction with the Forgotten Places & Spaces tours.

Upcoming Forgotten Places & Spaces Walking Tours: June 25, July 30, Aug. 20, Aug. 27, Sept. 24, Oct. 29, Nov. 19, and Dec. 17. Plans are being finalized to include tours of Underground Cambridge.

Advance registration is strongly encouraged; walk-ups are limited to space available. Forgotten Places & Spaces is a cooperative effort of Ohio-Made Getaways, Cambridge Main Street, and the Historic Preservation Committee. **To book your tickets, visit OhioMadeGetaways.com.**
