

2017 Official Travel Guide to Cambridge/Guernsey County Now Available

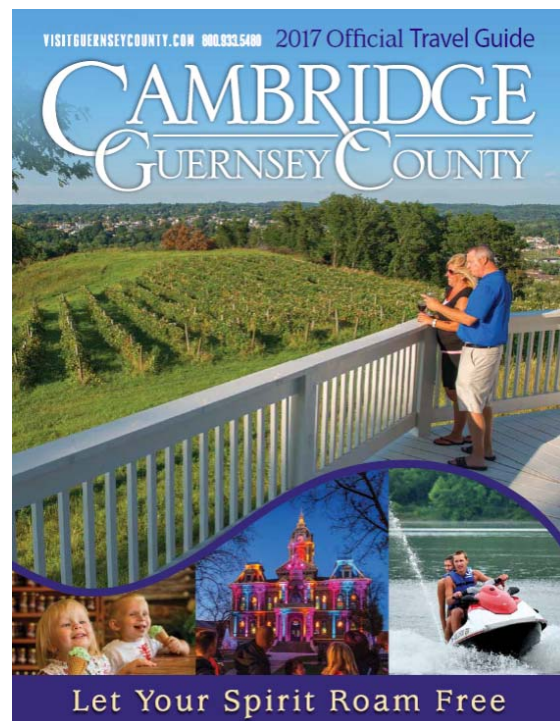
