2. **The Guernsey County History Museum** - 188 year old, restored 16 room home museum, containing antique furnishings, products and personal items from Guernsey County, including a display of an authentic one-room school house and a life like replica of a coal mine from the 1890's. 3. **Dickens Victorian Village** – Each holiday season (November 1 through December 31, 2016), the charming historic district of Cambridge, Ohio is transformed into an Old London, Dickens-themed wonderland, comprised of 190 life-size, handmade mannequins in breathtaking scenes from the great author’s canon. It’s like stepping into a storybook to bear witness to Bob Cratchit and Tiny Tim from A Christmas Carol, a town crier, a bucket brigade, lamplighters, school children, street peddlers and Father Christmas, all posed in active scenes that appear frozen in time. Inside the Dickens Welcome Center is the Imagination Station. This is the perfect stop for a family photo-op! Select the perfect Victorian hat, gloves and cape as you imagine being a Victorian yourself and posing for a picture with Charles Dickens or in front of the spectacular Victorian Christmas tree.
