1. Farm to Table: The Bear's Den Steakhouse serves locally produced beef, hand-cut and grilled to perfection. This family-owned restaurant offers a full menu of delicious burgers, ribs, chicken, seafood & pasta.



 Chocolate: Handcrafted in Cambridge, Nothing But Chocolate (need we say more?) is a chocoholic's dream! You'll feel as if you've stepped into Willy Wonka's Factory with the variety of gourmet chocolate caramel apples, nut clusters, fudge, and more to choose from.

- 3. Mile-High Pies: Theo's Restaurant in downtown Cambridge dishes up its famous mile-high lemon, peanut butter, and chocolate pies topped so high with a tasty homemade meringue—you may not see the person across the table! Dig in!
- 4. Spirited: The atmosphere at Central Station Steak & Ale hooks you from the start. The restaurant's homage to trains is rustic with a modern flare. The menu ranges from lobster bisque to ribeye. Slide up to a full bar for a drink of ale and other spirits.
- 5. Bake & Shake: The aroma of freshly baked glazed donuts, sugar cookies, pies and other goodies at Kennedy's Bakery envelope you the moment you walk through the door. "The Original," as the locals affectionately call it, has been part of the community since 1925. Kennedy's Cakes and Donuts, located just a few miles from downtown, boasts 11 showcases of pastries— making it the largest display of baked goods in the state of Ohio. The shop has placed first in the U.S.A. Baking Contest. Did we mention they also have over 1 million milkshake flavors?

6. Old Fashioned Drive-in: Orr's Drive In is a passage of spring. If you are going to eat a deep fried foot long Coney dog, peanut butter milkshake, onion rings, pizza burger or anything else that will make your mouth water and add a few pounds, this is the BEST place to find it! Family owned and operated for years (too many to count), the quality of their food is impeccable and made to perfection.
