What is the Visitors & Convention Bureau? How can they help you in your job?

Visitors & Convention Bureaus are not-for-profit organizations charged with representing a specific destination and helping the long-term development of communities through a travel and tourism strategy. Visitors & Convention Bureaus are organizations that bring together businesses that rely on tourism for revenue.

For visitors, VCB's are like a key to the community. As an unbiased resource, VCB's can serve as a broker or an official point of contact for convention and meeting planners, tour operators and visitors. They assist planners with meeting preparation and encourage business and leisure travelers alike to visit local historic, cultural, recreational sites and more.

The Cambridge/Guernsey County Visitors & Convention Bureau is located off both Interstates 70 and 77. Take exit 178 on I-70, turn North on Southgate Parkway. On I-77, take exit 46B, turn East on Rt. 40 (Wheeling Ave.) or exit 47, turn West onto St. Rt. 22. Follow the signs to the Tourist Information Center located in Historic Downtown Cambridge at 627 Wheeling Avenue.

The VCB is open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m.–5 p.m. and Saturday 9 a.m.–5 p.m.

The Cambridge/Guernsey VCB has all of the local tourist information that you will need about area attractions, events, dining and lodging.

Tourist information is also available on Sundays at Penny Court Antique Mall at 637 Wheeling Avenue from noon to 5 p.m.

About Guernsey County, Ohio

Cambridge/Guernsey County is located in the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains in beautiful southeastern Ohio, about 122 miles south of Cleveland, Ohio; 100 miles southwest of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; 50 miles west of Wheeling, West Virginia; and 80 miles east of Columbus, Ohio.

Interstate Highways 70 (East and West) and 77 (North and South) share five interchanges and one of the nation's largest cloverleaves at Cambridge. U.S. Rt. 40 (East and West) and 22 (Northeast and Southwest) plus St. Rt. 209 also network the area.

Approximately 40,000 people live in Guernsey County with approximately 10,000 living in the city of Cambridge, the county seat.

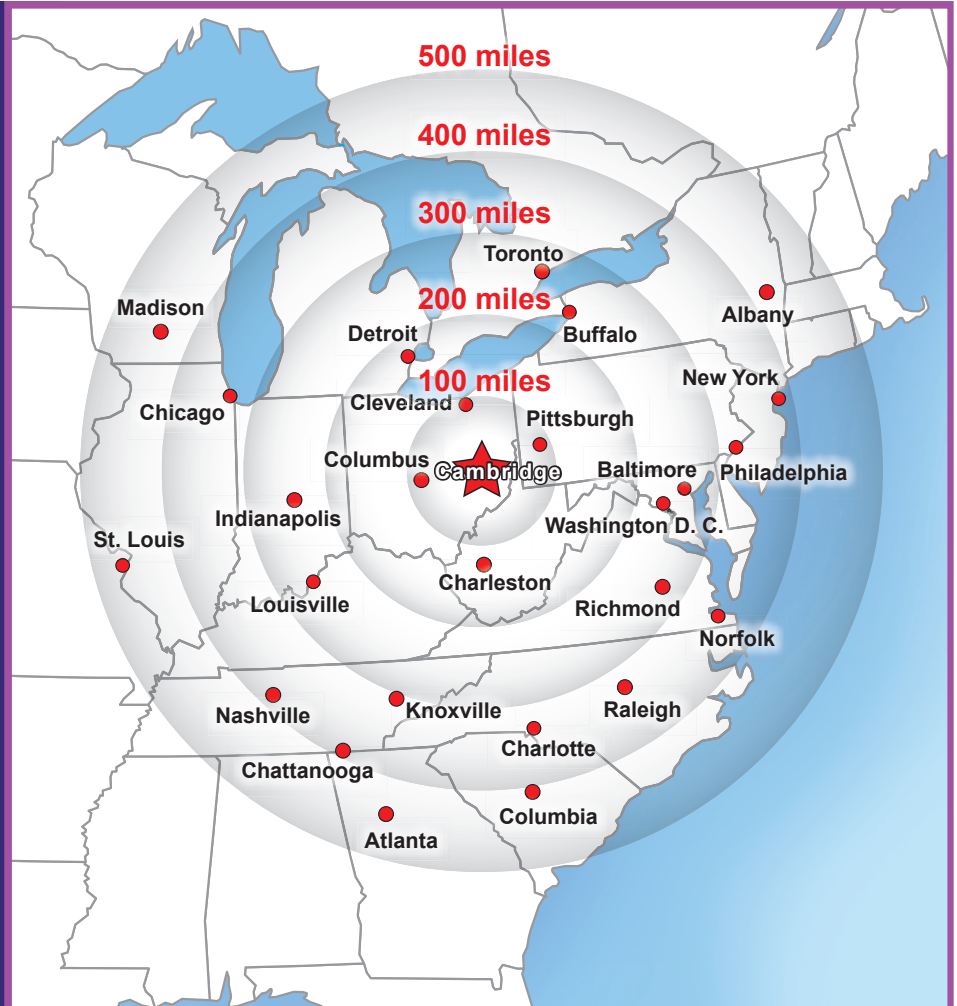
