That's why we're asking you – our attractions and businesses who market to visitors – to submit your event information for 2018. The bureau publishes a comprehensive list of area events in several forms – such as our annual travel guide, on our website, in our quarterly e-newsletters, my monthly Talking Tourism columns (like this one!), weekly Facebook postings, and through a separate printed six month calendar of events brochure.

If you are planning a 2018 event that will attract visitors to our area, you can now submit your information online on our new website. Simply log onto VisitGuernseyCounty.com, click on *Calendar of Events* and then *Submit an Event*. If you need help with your submission, contact Dawn Beasley (info@VisitGuernseyCounty.com), our office manager, who will happily walk you through the process.

Events can also be submitted online to the state's travel and tourism website, Ohio.org/Industry and from that, some could be chosen by Tourism Ohio to be listed in their Calendar of Events Magazines. It is important to know that each publication needs detailed information at least three to six months ahead of time.

Visitors who come to the area often stay overnight, shop downtown, eat in our local restaurants, and fuel up at our gas stations. They make a significant economic impact (typically \$100-\$300 per person, per visit). Events play a key role in attracting travelers to consider our destination over another location. So, please, submit your event information today!
