Veterans Tour

As we remember and recognize our Veterans, First Responders and Front-line heroes, learn how Guernsey County played an important roll in out nation's history.

- **Fletcher Chapel** (Spring through Fall)- *Was the spiritual hub of the 168 building, 2,000 bed Fletcher General Hospital. Located at the rail entryway to the giant complex, it greeted the 17,000 service men and women treated between 1943 & 1946. Driving tour.*
- **Guernsey History Museum**- *Over 190 year old, restored 16-room home, containing antique furnishings, products and personal items from Guernsey County including a display of an authentic one-room school house and a lifelike replica of a coal mine from the 1890s. A must see is the "military room" in this eclectic museum.*
- **National Museum of Cambridge Glass**- *The National Museum of Cambridge Glass houses the world's most extensive collection of glass produced by The Cambridge Glass Company from 1902 through 1958. When the men went to war, women and children filled manufacturing and agricultural positions on the homefront.*
