This can be a one- day or multi-day tour that includes experiencing and learning about Eastern Ohio's Flora and Fauna for soft adventure or student groups!

Start your day at **Seneca Lake Fish Hatchery** for an overview of Ohio indigenous fish and what anglers might find in the water: Channel catfish, flathead catfish, bullheads, white bass, striped bass, largemouth bass, crappie, bluegill, yellow perch and walleye. **Monday- Friday 9am-3pm.**

Take a **Pontoon Boat Ride** on Seneca Lake. Your guide will point out our feathered friends who reside here like the osprey and eagle along with many mammal species.

Enjoy lunch at **Dockside Restaurant** on the enclosed porch in the Marina over the water and enjoy the beautiful view and fresh air!





Or you may wish to enjoy an upscale boxed lunch prepared especially for your group by the Dockside Chef and head over to **Deerassic Park Education Center** after the Seneca Lake Experience.

Afternoon activities at the park include:

Wonders of the Whitetail at Deerassic Park – explores the historical, cultural and biological impact of the Whitetail Deer with an opportunity to view the deer herd in a walk-through an enclosed environment. From trophy bucks to newborn fawns, what your group sees will be different from season to season. Be sure to check out the brand new Interactive Outdoor Display!



Archery – Can take place inside or outside depending on skill levels. Even beginners with no shooting experience will enjoy! For more advanced participants, the session can be turned into a competition.

Marksmanship and firearm safety – (Simulation indoor fire arms) A great way to familiarize your group with the basics of firearms, their usage and operation. A safety and handling lecture will be provided followed by either shooting air rifles at targets outside or through an interactive firearms simulator.

Canoe Canoe where are you? -Small groups will enjoy this interactive time waterside or on the water learning the sport of canoeing. 30 minute quick start program will be given!

The John & Annie History Museum-New Concord, Ohio. Astronaut/Senator John Glenn's boyhood home has been restored as it was when he lived there until his enlistment in World War II. Enjoy a first person interpretation of life as it was during the Great Depression and on the Home Front during WWII.

The Works-Newark, Ohio is a great destination for visitors of any age! Each year, the museum welcomes hundreds of people eager to explore and experience all The Works has to offer. The two-story museum houses countless exhibits dedicated to the history of Licking County's transportation, manufacturing, and industry. Tour groups are also introduced to a beautiful art gallery space, restored interurban railway car, and hands-on science labs. Groups may also elect to add to their tour experience by visiting The Works Letter Press, Ohio & Erie Canal Lock #9 or watching a live glass blowing demonstration in the Glass Studio.

A Canal Boat Ride – Coshocton, Ohio. The Monticello III, a horse-drawn canal boat replica takes visitors on a 40 minute ride into Ohio's colorful past with a glimpse of a 1 1/2 mile restored section of the original Ohio-Erie Canal in Coshocton.
