VCB MARKETING INITIATIVES

The bureau staff and its agency of record, Stonewall Group, have prepared an aggressive marketing campaign for 2022. The VCB has increased its digital efforts, as well as planned several traditional marketing strategies.

The bureau's **outdoor board campaign** in Zanesville will return this year May-September with five partners participating: Deerassic Park, The Living Word Outdoor Drama, Salt Fork Arts & Crafts Festival, Guernsey County Fair and Paul Bunyan Show. Keep an eye out for them while you are in Zanesville!

A brand **new website** is currently being created for the VCB by Stonewall Group. A beautiful new design will engage users, helping them navigate the site better and, ultimately, make plans to visit this region. The bureau anticipates launching the site mid to late May.

The VCB's spring-summer **digital campaign** will coincide with the launch of the new website in May and continues through August. The VCB will then resume a month-long digital campaign in November focused on Dickens Victorian Village.

In June and July, the bureau will work with **TourismOhio** on three **co-op programs**. The first will be to host a travel influencer. This person will visit the area and write a series of social media and blog posts about Cambridge/Guernsey County. The second co-op will include a professional video shoot with the goal to create a :30sec video usable on social media platforms and television. And the final co-op will place the finished video on YouTube for advertising in July.
