

## Instagram-Worthy Autumn Sites in Southeast Ohio

CAMBRIDGE, OHIO (Sept. 16, 2022) – The autumn season throughout southeast Ohio provides a respite from summer’s heat. The beautiful patchwork of autumn colors ushers in stunning Instagram-worthy sites to explore and photograph.

Families particularly love all that **Salt Fork State Park**, Ohio’s largest, has to offer. Salt Fork is an outdoor oasis with more than 20,000 acres of land to explore. The park offers 14 scenic hiking trails and six bridle trails, not to mention a 3,000 acre lake for fishing and boating. Three picture perfect spots include the hike to Hosak’s Cave (a Civil War hide-out), Kennedys Stone House Museum (circa 1840s) and the overview of the lake from the lodge grounds.

Speaking of lakes, **Seneca Lake** is the ideal spot to surround oneself with the season’s color. Rent a boat or kayak and spend time on the lake drinking in the spectacular view. Seneca is Ohio’s third largest inland lake and provides plenty of room for fun on the water, not to mention new RV and camping sites.

If you’re looking for scenic spots closer to town check out the Great Guernsey Trail and Georgetown Tavern on the Hill.

Enjoy a leisurely stroll with your family or a relaxing 14-mile round trip bike ride on a low-grade paved path as part of the Great Guernsey Trail. The fiery fall colors are on full display from every angle.

**Georgetown Tavern on the Hill** is a family-friendly pizzeria and winery overlooking Cambridge. From the back deck you will gaze upon the expansive vineyard while catching a glimpse of Guernsey County’s 1883 Victorian Courthouse. Enjoy one-of-a-kind brick oven pizzas and variety of specialty drinks and wines – inside or out.

However you choose to enjoy the season, the brilliance of autumn’s colors and crisp air are sure to refresh one’s soul and delight the eyes in Guernsey County, Ohio.
