Coloring & Activity Book

The bureau unveiled its new children's coloring and activity book at the Cambridge Area Chamber of Commerce Home, Garden & Business Expo in March. The 24-page book consists of 10 coloring pages created by VCB intern, Sydney Campbell.

Campbell's coloring pages celebrate iconic sites in Guernsey County included: Theo's Restaurant's 'mile high' pie, kayaking on Seneca Lake, Nothing But Chocolate's goodies, Kennedy's Bakery doughnuts, the Guernsey County Courthouse Holiday Light Show, Georgetown Tavern's pizza, The Living Word Outdoor Drama's centurion and horse, a display of glass from the National Museum of Cambridge Glass, the Cambridge Arch that welcomes people to downtown Cambridge and, of course, Bigfoot.

In addition to the coloring pages, area tourism partners submitted activity pages that included mazes, tic-tac-toe, crossword puzzles and word searches.

The bureau printed 5,000 copies and will distribute the book at special events. The book is also available online at www.VisitGuernseyCounty.com/kids/ and is free to download.
