The celebration of the nation's 247th birthday continues with the **Cambridge City Band's free concert** on July 4th at the Cambridge City Park. Established in 1841, the band is Ohio's oldest continuously performing community band. Concert begins at 7:30 p.m. Food and beverages will be available on site. There will be fun for the kids throughout the day. Bring your lawn chairs and blankets to watch the annual Cambridge Boom-A-Rama fireworks display at dusk.

If you want to extend your holiday activities in the area, check-out **The Ohio Hills Folk Festival** July 5-8 in Quaker City. Celebrating 119 years, the festival is one of Ohio's oldest.

The festival celebrates the history of the Quaker community with parades, free entertainment, art, quilt, car shows, crafts, flea market, 5k run, kids games, tractor peddle pull, bike and duck races, contests, amusement rides and lots of great food! Make sure to stop at the country store on East Main Street and enjoy homemade ice cream, fudge, baked items and other delicious treats. Other locally made favorites include local cheese and trail bologna.
