## Official Paul Bunyan Show<sup>SM</sup> planned for Oct. 6-8 at Guernsey County Fairgrounds

CAMBRIDGE, OHIO (Sept. 12, 2023) – For 65 years, one of the nation’s largest and oldest forest industry trade shows, The Official Paul Bunyan Show<sup>SM</sup> has offered a unique opportunity for families to celebrate Ohio’s forestry background. The 2023 Official Paul Bunyan Show<sup>SM</sup> will take place October 6-8, 2023 at the Guernsey County Fairgrounds located just outside of Cambridge (Old Washington), Ohio.

“The annual Paul Bunyan Show is by far one of the best family-oriented events you can attend,” Cambridge/Guernsey County Visitor & Convention Bureau Executive Director Debbie Robinson said. “Everyone will find something they enjoy watching, learning or buying!”
