The Cambridge/Guernsey County VCB Grant Assistance Program (GAP) assists qualified non-profit organizations with the advertising and promotion of activities which directly increase lodging occupancy in designated periods throughout the year, create positive image building publicity for the Cambridge/Guernsey County area, and enhance the tourism environment of our area.

For 11 years now, the VCB has facilitated grants ranging from a minimum of \$500 to \$5,000. The grants are contingent upon the amount of overnight stays the event, project or program generates. The deadline to submit applications is March 1, 2024. Grants will be awarded by the end of March 2024.
