2024 Group & Leisure Shows

Dixie Lacy (VCB Sales Manager) is representing Cambridge/Guernsey County at the annual Heartland Travel Showcase in South Bend, Indiana (March 1-3) along with the Living Word Outdoor Drama. The Heartland region is known for its warm hospitality and excitement for group tours! This annual show is designed to foster networking and create sales opportunities for tourism related businesses and events throughout the Heartland states (Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Michigan, Minnesota, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, West Virginia, and Canada. During the show, Dixie and Heath will meet one-on-one with tour operators to book groups to our area in 2024-2025 and build relationships.

In 2023, the area welcomed a total of 48 bus groups. This was a slight increase in groups compared to 2022.

The bureau will also participate in the Cambridge Area Chamber Of Commerce's Home, Garden & Business Expo on March 8 & 9 Pritchard Laughlin Civic Center. There will be 14 Guernsey County tourism partners featured in the Travel & Tourism Room. Now in its 11th year, the Cambridge/Guernsey County VCB Grant Assistance Program (GAP) assists qualified non-profit organizations with the advertising and promotion of activities which directly increase lodging occupancy in designated periods throughout the year, create positive image building publicity for the Cambridge/Guernsey County area and enhance the tourism environment of our area.

Grants are available from a minimum of \$500 to \$5,000 and will be contingent upon the amount of overnight stays the event, project or program generates. The deadline to submit applications is March 1, 2024. Grants recipients will be announced on March 29, 2024.
