Check-out what's coming up:

The **Byesville Fireman's Festival** on June 28 & 29 will feature a 5k run/walk, car show, live entertainment, great food, bounce houses, mini golf, smash car, games, raffles and giveaways. Be sure to stay for Byesville Blast at Dark fireworks show on June 29<sup>th</sup> at 10 p.m.!

The celebration of the nation's 248<sup>th</sup> birthday continues with the **Cambridge City Band's free concert** on July 4<sup>th</sup> at the Cambridge City Park. Established in 1841, the band is Ohio's oldest continuously performing community band. Concert begins at 7:30 p.m. Food and beverages will be available on site. There will be fun for the kids throughout the day. Bring your lawn chairs and blankets to watch the annual Cambridge Boom-A-Rama fireworks display at dusk.

If you want to extend your holiday activities in the area, check-out **The Ohio Hills Folk Festival** July 10-13 in Quaker City. Celebrating 120 years, the festival is one of Ohio's oldest. The festival celebrates the history of the Quaker community with parades, free entertainment, art, quilt, car shows, crafts, flea market, 5k run, kids games, tractor peddle pull, bike and duck races, contests, amusement rides and lots of great food! Make sure to stop at the country store on East Main Street and enjoy homemade ice cream, fudge, baked items and other delicious treats. Other locally made favorites include local cheese and trail bologna.
