## YEAR IN REVIEW

Looking back on 2024 the Cambridge/Guernsey County area experienced tourism growth in several areas – by way of milestones (The Living Word Outdoor Drama Celebrated its 50<sup>th</sup> season) and new Seneca Lake Splash Pad opening and the Salt Fork State Park Eco-Discovery Center opening soon. The bureau is pleased to share a few of its own successes in 2024. Check them out:

### **NEW! Wild About Wine Tour**

In June, the bureau launched a new campaign, Wild About Wine. The new trail is designed to encourage wine and craft beer enthusiasts to discover Southeast Ohio's most prestigious wineries and breweries. Three neighboring counties - Guernsey, Coshocton and Muskingum – and The Wilds are working together to promote the new spirit's trail. Learn more at visitguernseycounty.com/wild-about-wine/.

# **Summer Campaign Success**

The bureau's **outdoor board campaign** in Zanesville once again highlighted five area tourism partners (Deerassic Park Education Center, The Living Word Outdoor Drama, Salt Fork Arts & Crafts Festival, Guernsey County Fair and Paul Bunyan Show). Boards were on display in various locations May through September.

The VCB's **digital & broadcast campaigns** expanded in 2024. Digital ad placements were placed May through August to promote general summer getaways, the new Wild About Wine tour and fairs and festivals. A professional commercial aired on WTOV Channel 9 during the Memorial Day Weekend, as well as on YouTube in June. Digital media partners include AdOhio and MediaOne. The bureau experienced stellar results.

Year-over-year (through July 30, 2024):

- Visitor Sessions to the VCB website were up 46%.
- Organic Traffic to the VCB website was up 103%.
- Top 3 markets Cleveland, Columbus and Pittsburgh
- YouTube Summer Video Views 62% of viewers watched the entire ad

## **NEW! Dickens Victorian Village Commercial**

In November, the VCB unveiled its new 30 second commercial promoting Dickens Victorian Village. The bureau took advantage of a TourismOhio co-op in late 2023 that paired destinations with video production companies to produce video assets appropriate for use in broadcast TV, digital TV, website, digital ads and social media. The PPS Group from Cincinnati, Ohio visited Cambridge last December to capture the magic and wonder of Dickens Victorian Village. ## **Economic Impact Report of Ohio Travel**

The VCB took part in a state-wide economic impact of tourism study in 2023. This information is a result of an integrated consumer-based research study organized by TourismOhio and conducted by Tourism Economic - An Oxford Economics Company.

According to the report, Cambridge/Guernsey County's tourism industry contributed more than \$30 million in local taxes; generated \$227 million in sales for local businesses and sustained 1,777 local jobs (8.7% of private employment) in 2023. In addition, each household in Guernsey County would need to be taxed an additional \$962 to replace the visitor generated taxes received by state and local governments in 2023.
