Raise a glass to good times in Guernsey County, Ohio! With a growing craft beer scene and charming vineyards, there's something to satisfy every taste.

Discover seasonal flavors at the locally-owned Guernsey Brewhouse where you can sample a variety of handcrafted beers – from shandies and lagers to IPAs and seasonal or fruity options – in a relaxed atmosphere. A rotating series of local food trucks like Mr. Ted's Thai and Oma's #1 pair well with the tasty brews on tap. This Cambridge brewery also hosts local musicians and events like trivia, Oktoberfest and even family-friendly classes.

Whether you're a wine aficionado or just love the look of the rolling hills, don't miss the hilltop views of the local, family-owned and operated Georgetown Tavern, overlooking the gorgeous Georgetown Vineyards. Events, live music, yoga and more keep the hilltop hopping. This family-friendly venue provides a full menu of pizzas, salads and more, along with craft brews, signature alcohol-infused slushie drinks and, of course, the local vintage of wine.

For beer connoisseurs, aspiring sommeliers or simply those who enjoy a casual drink and good company in an unfussy atmosphere, Guernsey County offers a delightful taste of the local beverage scene.

Enjoy our year-round Wild About Wine tour that takes wine and craft beer enthusiasts through three neighboring counties – Guernsey, Coshocton and Muskingum. A total of 15 stops for craft beer and local wine lovers await exploration, including two must-experience stops right here in Guernsey County: Georgetown Vineyard, a relaxed, hilltop winery and pizza stop with stunning views, and Guernsey Brewhouse.
