GAP Deadline

Is your Guernsey County nonprofit organization, event or business looking for support to boost tourism and increase visibility? The GAP program is here to help! Designed to support area tourism partners in marketing efforts, this program offers grants that assist with the advertising and promotion of activities that drive lodging occupancy during key travel periods. Additionally, GAP helps create positive, image-building publicity for the area.

For 13 years now, the VCB has facilitated grants ranging from a minimum of \$500 to \$5,000. The grants are contingent upon the amount of overnight stays the event, project or program generates. The deadline to submit applications is February 1, 2026. Grants will be awarded March 27, 2026.
