



The Hopalong Cassidy Trail recognizes the impact of William Boyd, Cambridge, Ohio's beloved cowboy hero. A collection of Hopalong Cassidy items are on display at the Cambridge/Guernsey County Tourist Information Center.

- The history of William Boyd, from Hendrysburg to Hollywood, can be seen in a mural at the LAW OFFICES OF SAIA & PIATT, INC. building located at 122 Southgate Pkwy on the corner of Southgate Pkwy and Turner Ave.
- The site of the school attended by William Boyd at Wheeling and Highland Avenue is home to a monument and the Hopalong Cassidy walk dedicated to his memory at the corner of Wheeling Ave and Highland Ave (150 Highland Ave).
- An exhibit is also displayed at the CAMBRIDGE/GUERNSEY COUNTY TOURIST INFORMATION CENTER located at 627 Wheeling Avenue. Meet Hopalong Cassidy historian who will share interesting stories about Hoppy's life.
- A remarkable six- foot bronze statue greets visitors and residents alike at the GUERNSEY COUNTY SENIOR CENTER located at 1022 Carlisle Ave. Groups can take their pictures by the Hoppy statue (ample room for motorcoach parking) and enjoy a meal in the center while interacting with Hopalong Cassidy historian and creator of the 25-year old Hopalong Cassidy Festival in Cambridge. Although the festival is no longer held, Laura Bates, will delight your group with stories about Hopalong Cassidy and his beautiful wife, Grace Bradley Boyd, who attended the festival each year.

Watch a vintage film showing the Cambridge artisans as they demonstrate the handmade glassmaking process inside the famous glasshouse. You can dress as glassworkers and hold the original tools that were used to manufacture each piece. Stroll through colorful displays featuring over 10,000 pieces of handmade Cambridge Glass. Make a pencil rubbing from an authentic etching plate once used by the company, known worldwide for quality, as a souvenir.

New for 2026 is the America 250-Ohio mural depicting the history of the Cambridge Glass Factory.

Did you know that The Cambridge Glass Company even had their own restaurant? The pie was delicious! Visit the recreation of the “much loved” restaurant and take a selfie seated with the workers enjoying their pie!

This museum consists of 3 different exhibit areas. The first is about The National Road, America's first federally funded highway, also known as "The Main Street of America." A 136' diorama illustrates the construction of the road at various phases and shows how progress followed it. There are also many examples of transportation which would have traveled the road including an authentic Conestoga wagon, a stagecoach sleigh, a steam car and a surrey with fringe on top. Also you'll find the Zane Grey area which is a tribute to locally born western author, Zane Grey, who wrote over 80 novels some of which turned into 100 different movies. And in the center of the museum, a gallery displays beautiful examples of locally produced art and ceramic pottery. Groups visiting both the National Road & Zane Grey Museum and the John & Annie Glenn Museum will receive the discounted rate of \$10 each.



Look through this window into the past on the shore of beautiful Salt Fork Lake. This lovely Stone House has been restored to its 1840's appearance complete with a summer kitchen and existing unique root cellar. The summer kitchen, built adjacent to the main house, lessened the possibility of fire and also kept the main house cooler in the summer. The kitchen was used year round for the preparation of food as well as butchering and canning. The ox yoke on display above the fireplace was worn on oxen that hauled the sand stone to the site by the Irish masons who built the house.
